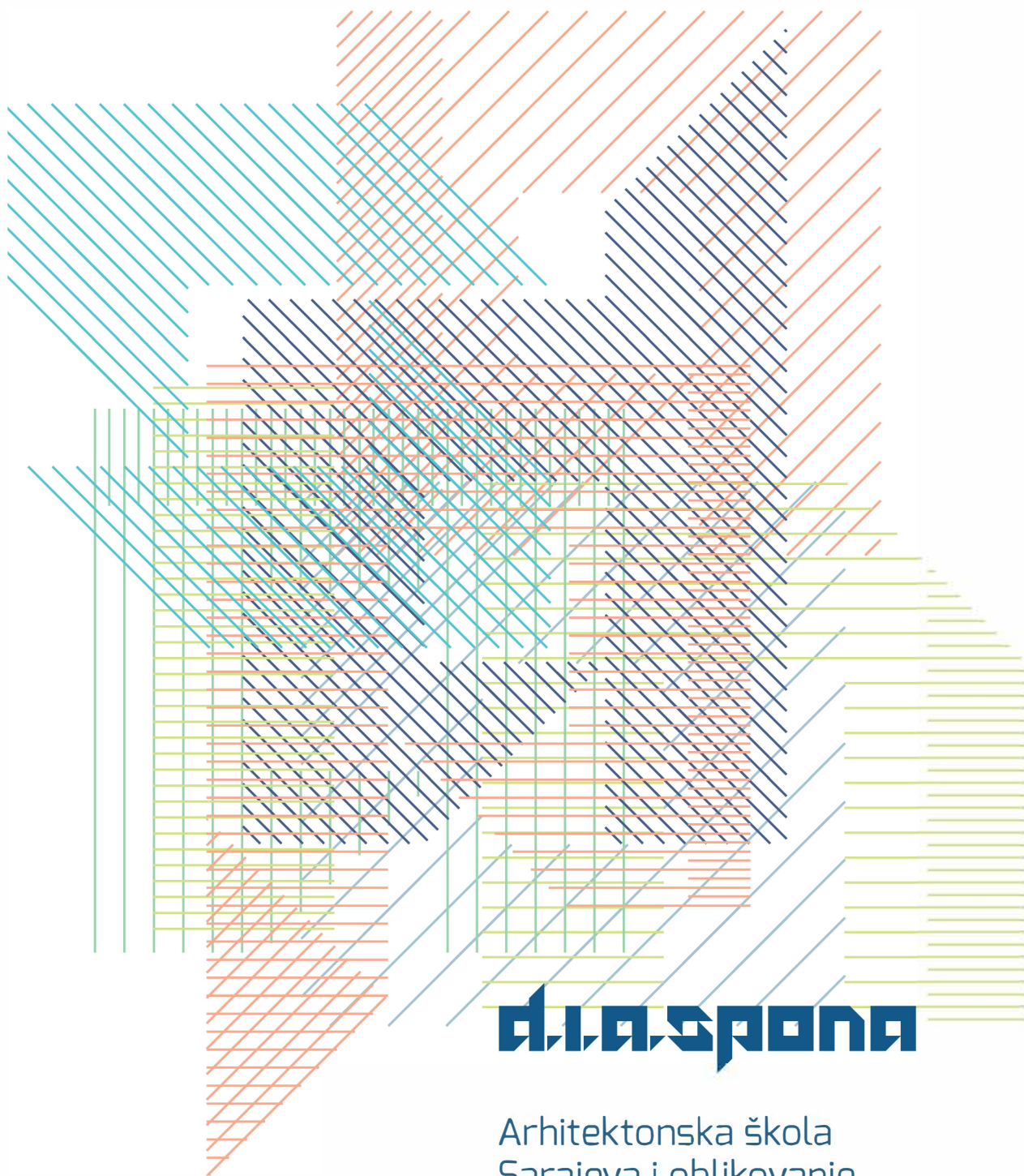
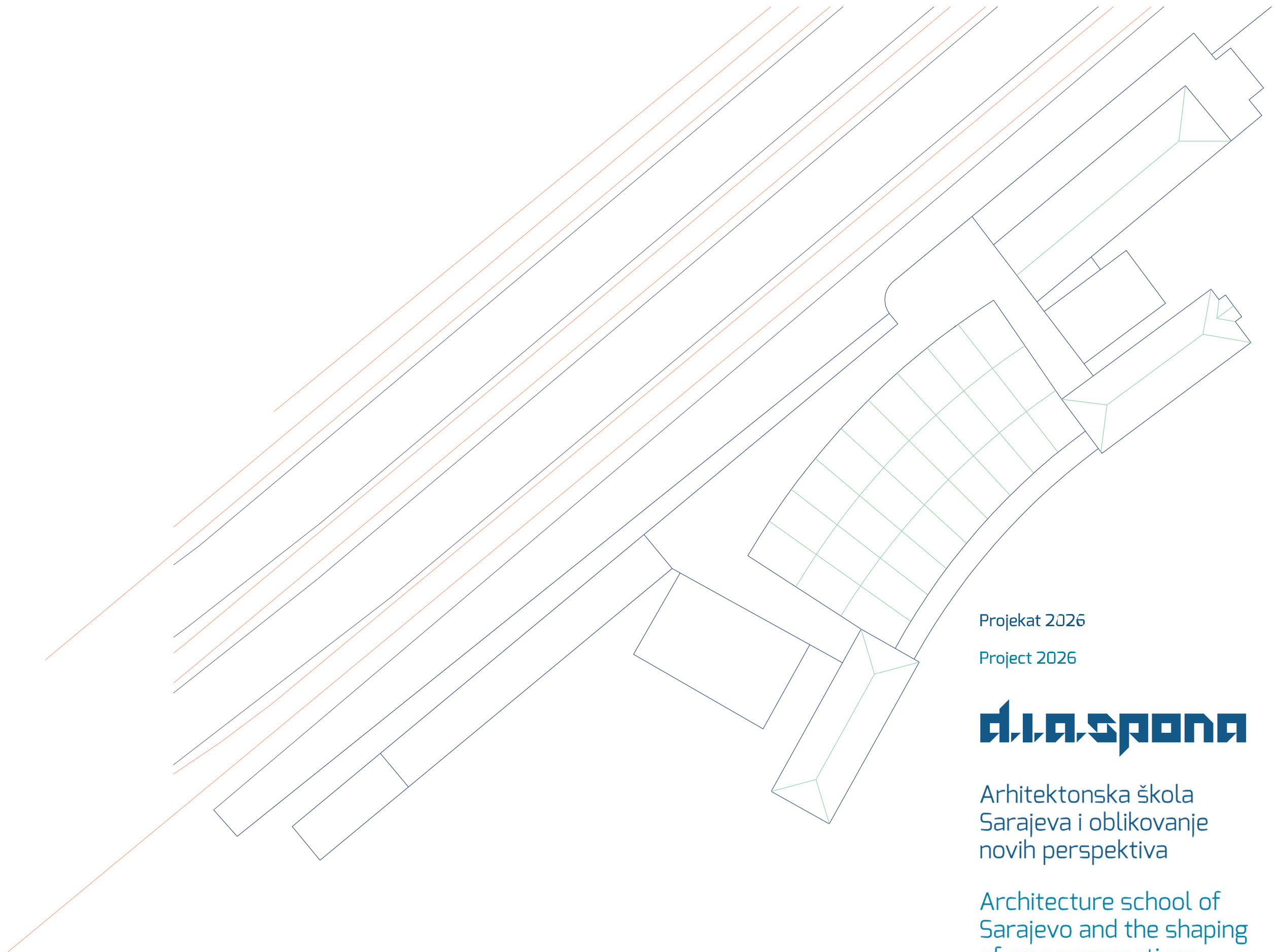

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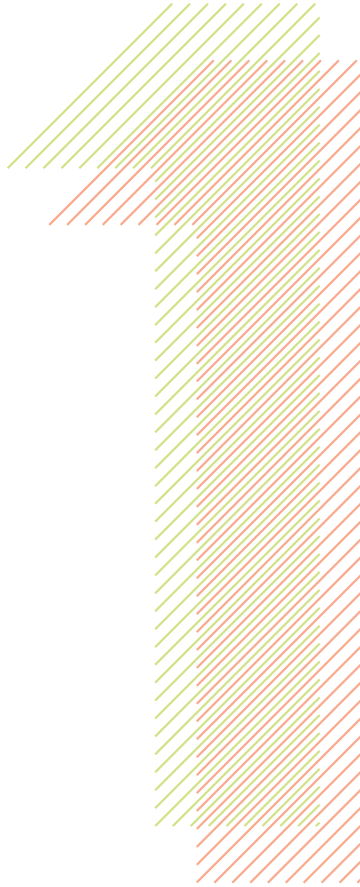
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Uvod

Izložba d.i.a.spona okuplja arhitekthe Arhitektonskog fakulteta u Sarajevu koji su svoje profesionalne karijere ostvarili izvan Bosne i Hercegovine, prikazujući njihova djela kroz multimodalnu i interaktivnu postavku. Kroz radove više od šezdeset arhitekata izložba će predstaviti njihove najvažnije projekte – od skica i crteža do maketa i videoprezentacija.

Na čelu projekta je Hasan Ćemalović, d.i.a., uz Stručni savjet, Lejla Hajro, d.i.a., vodi menadžment projekta, a značajnu ulogu dokumentiranja radova i profesionalnih puteva učesnika imaju prof. dr. Aida Abadžić-Hodžić, doc. dr. Lejla Kahrović-Handžić i doc. dr. Nermina Zagora. Amer Mržljak, docent Akademije likovnih umjetnosti, zadužen je za identitet izložbe dok PR strategiju vodi mr. Una Bejtović. Tehnički sekretar Irfan Salihagić, d.i.a., koordinira tehničke aspekte organizacije izložbe uz menadžera projekta. Zadatak implementacije projekta ima Udruženje “LIFT – prostorne inicijative” dok je partner na projektu “Walter aec d.o.o.” Sarajevo. Izložba će se održati u auli Željezničke stanice Sarajevo, izabranoj zbog svoje historijske i arhitektonske vrijednosti. Prostor pruža priliku za revitalizaciju ovog značajnog modernističkog objekta iz 20. stoljeća, čime se stvaraju pretpostavke za njegove nove funkcije. Pripreme su počele u novembru 2025. godine formiran je tim za realizaciju izložbe, koja će biti otvorena u oktobru 2026. godine. Tokom ovog perioda bit će organizirane radionice, promotivne kampanje i izdavačke aktivnosti. Projekt će, također, obuhvatiti štampanje dviju knjiga – Put u arhitekturu i Zbornik radova – koje će dokumentirati životni put, rad i djela učesnika izložbe.

Cilj izložbe jeste predstaviti dostignuća arhitekata obrazovanih u Sarajevu, ojačati veze među generacijama, promovirati razmjenu znanja među stručnjacima u Bosni i Hercegovini i svijetu, revitalizirati Željezničku stanicu kao kulturni spomenik i ojačati veze među mladim arhitektima širom svijeta.



Introduction

The exhibition d.i.a.spona brings together architects from the Faculty of Architecture in Sarajevo who have pursued their professional careers outside of Bosnia and Herzegovina, showcasing their work through a multimodal and interactive display. With the works of over 60 architects, the exhibition will present their most significant projects, from sketches and drawings to models and video presentations.

The project is led by Hasan Ćemalović, MArch, along with an Expert Council, Lejla Hajro, MArch manages the project, while the important role of documenting the works and professional paths of the participants is held by Professor Aida Abadžić Hodžić, Lejla Kahrović Handžić, and Associate Professor Nermina Zagora. Amer Mržljak, Associate Professor at the Academy of Fine Arts, is responsible for the exhibition’s identity, while the PR strategy is led by Una Bejtović. Technical secretary Irfan Salihagić, MArch, coordinates the technical aspects of the exhibition’s organization along with the project manager. The task of implementing the project is undertaken by the Association “LIFT – spatial initiatives,” while the partner on the project is Walter aec LLC Sarajevo.

The exhibition will be held in the atrium of the Sarajevo Railway Station, chosen for its historical and architectural value. This space offers an opportunity to revitalize a significant modernist building from the 20th century, creating the potential for new functions.

Preparations began in November 2025, a team was formed for the realization of the Exhibition, which will open in October 2026. During this period, workshops, promotional campaigns, and publishing activities will be organized. The project will also include the publication of two books – Monography “Your path” and “Proceedings” – which will document the life paths, works, and achievements of the participants.

The goal of the exhibition is to showcase the achievements of architects educated in Sarajevo, strengthen intergenerational ties, promote knowledge exchange among professionals in Bosnia and Herzegovina and the world, revitalize a cultural monument, and strengthen connections among young architects worldwide.

Cilj izložbe

Ideja o predstavljanju arhitekata školovanih na Arhitektonskom fakultetu u Sarajevu nastala je iz želje za predstavljanjem njihovog rada, naše škole arhitekture, a zamišljena je kao interaktivna izložba. U auli Željezničke stanice Sarajevo bit će predstavljeno više od šezdeset arhitekata i arhitektica sa svojim najznačajnijim, ali i lično najposebnijim, djelima nastalim tokom njihovog višedecenijskog rada u inostranstvu. Sedamdeset pet godina postojanja Fakulteta znači isto toliko školovanih generacija iz kojih su pojedinci svoj stvaralački pečat ostavili u mnogim zemljama svijeta. Prvi put, kroz ovu izložbu, želimo ih okupiti na jednom mjestu, u imponantnom ambijentu Željezničke stanice, aktivirajući tako i njenu aulu, ali i otvoreni prostor trga kao jedne od značajnih otvorenih javnih površina Grada Sarajeva.

Posebna pažnja posvećena je i prikladnom nazivu ovog izuzetnog projekta, pa ime d.i.a.spona odražava i okosnicu struke, titulu, ali i vezu sa studentima našeg fakulteta u svijetu koju ovim putem nastojimo ojačati. Vrijedi napomenuti da pozvani učesnici predstavljaju i zemlje u kojima trenutno žive, u kojima su ostvarili profesionalne uspjehe i postali značajni članovi društva.

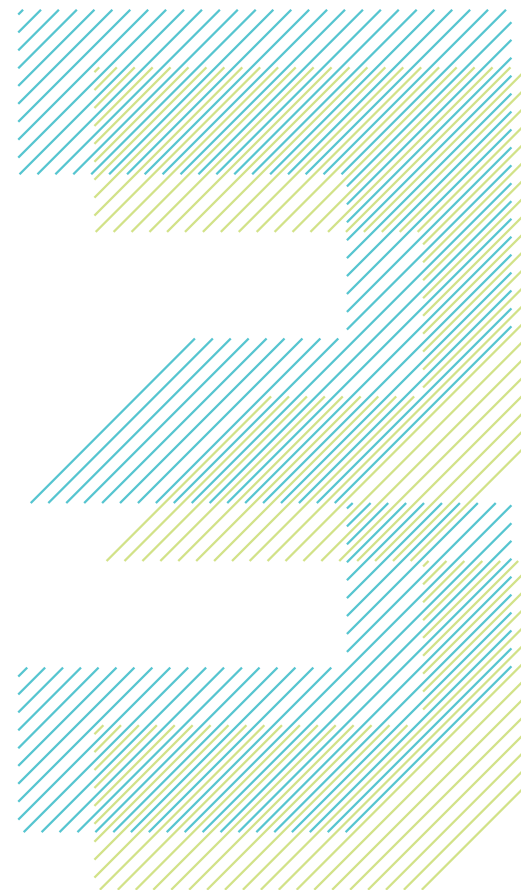
Objective of the Exhibition

The idea of presenting architects educated at the Faculty of Architecture Sarajevo originated from the desire to showcase their work, our architecture school, and was envisioned as an interactive exhibition. Over sixty (60) architects and architecture practitioners, with their most significant as well as personally unique works developed over decades of work abroad, will be presented in the atrium of the Sarajevo Railway Station. Seventy-five (75) years of the Faculty’s existence means the same number of educated generations, from which individuals have left their creative mark in many countries around the world. For the first time, through this exhibition, we aim to bring them together in one place, in the impressive setting of the Sarajevo Railway Station, activating its atrium as well as the open space of the square as one of the significant public areas of the City of Sarajevo.

Special attention has been given to an appropriate name for this significant project; hence, the name d.i.a.spona reflects both the essence of the profession, our title, and the connection with our faculty’s students abroad, which we aim to strengthen through this initiative.

The exhibition has more than one goal; it is not only about showcasing the achievements of established creators but also emphasising the exchange of knowledge and experiences with architects of new generations educated in Sarajevo, who work and create beyond the borders of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the region.

Invited participants who have confirmed their attendance will present their projects through sketches, drawings, plans, models, video works, and presentations in various dimensions and on different surfaces, narrating a visual story of their creative work, presenting their most significant achievements, while reflecting on their developmental journey - from its beginnings in Sarajevo, through events and experiences from around the world, to their return to Sarajevo for the d.i.a.spona Exhibition. It is worth noting that the invited participants also represent the countries in which they currently reside, where they have achieved professional success and become significant members of society.

Mjesto održavanja izložbe

Mjesto održavanja izložbe je aula Željezničke stanice u Sarajevu, proglašena nacionalnim spomenikom zbog izuzetne arhitektonske vrijednosti. Prednost izbora ove lokacije jedinstvena je prilika za revitalizaciju ovog historijski i arhitektonski značajnog objekta, koji je trenutno u dosta lošem stanju. Sredstva namijenjena za pripremu izložbenog prostora ne samo da bi unaprijedila funkcionalnost objekta već bi mu dala i novu namjenu i značaj te doprinijela njegovoj trajnoj zaštiti i prezentaciji vrijednosti kulturnog spomenika.

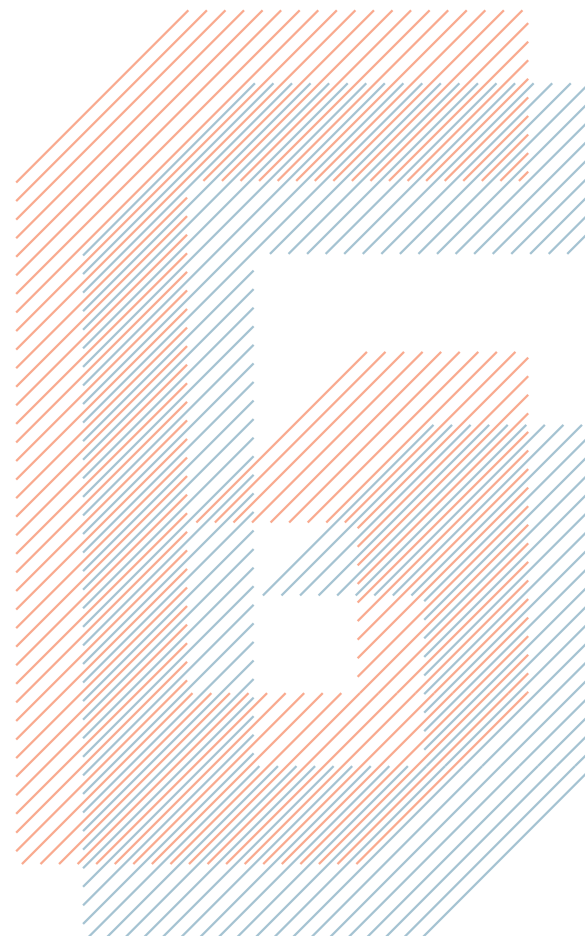
Smještena je u gradskoj općini Novo Sarajevo, a izgrađena je između 1947. i 1952. godine, prema originalnom projektu čeških arhitekata Kohouta, Prohaske i Hacara, a kasnije je završena pod vodstvom Bogdana Stojkova. Arhitektonski gledajući, stanica je značajan primjer modernističke arhitekture iz sredine 20. stoljeća u Bosni i Hercegovini. Njen centralni element prostrana je željeznička aula s tlocrtnom osnovom u obliku isječka prstena, podijeljena na devet segmenata s nosivim stubovima. Konstrukcija aule uključuje parabolične hiperboloide prednapregnutog armiranog betona, koji stvaraju dinamičnu, zakrivljenu liniju krova. Krila zgrade raspoređena su oko centralne aule i povezane sa željezničkim peronima i ostalim funkcionalnim prostorima. Svojom monumentalnošću i funkcionalnošću stanica je simbol arhitektonske inovacije tog perioda dok su naknadne obnove, posebno nakon oštećenja tokom rata 1992–1995, očuvale njenu arhitektonsku i kulturnu vrijednost.

Dizajn izložbe

Članovi Savjeta (Kustoski tim) izložbe koordinirat će rad na Izložbi do donošenja konačne odluke o projektima koji će biti prezentirani, kako bi se osigurala raznolika i reprezentativna selekcija, koja naglašava raspon i značaj doprinosa istaknutih arhitekata.

Poseban arhitektonski projekt bit će sam dizajn Izložbe koji će proizaći iz pojedinačnih prijedloga svakog izlagača, mogućnosti prostora te arhitektonskog natječaja, koji će uključiti planiranje rasporeda s ciljem stvaranja koherentnog i zanimljivog toka, usmjeravajući posjetitelje kroz izložbu i poboljšavajući njihovo razumijevanje i uvažavanje izloženih radova.

Bit će pripremljeni neophodni interpretativni materijali, uključujući opise, oznake i pozadinske informacije za svaki rad. Ovi materijali trebaju biti dostupni i na engleskom jeziku kako bi se zadovoljila šira publika i pružio dublji uvid u kontekst i značaj svakog djela.



Exhibition venue

The venue for the exhibition is the atrium of the Sarajevo Railway Station, which has been declared a national monument due to its exceptional architectural value. The advantage of choosing this location is the unique opportunity to revitalise a historically and architecturally significant building that is currently in poor condition. The funds allocated for preparing the exhibition space will not only enhance the functionality of the building but will also provide it with a new purpose and significance, contributing to its long-term protection and the presentation of the cultural monument's value.

Located in the Novo Sarajevo municipal district, it was constructed between 1947 and 1952 according to the original design by Czech architects Kohout, Prohaska, and Hacara, and was later completed under the guidance of Bogdan Stojkov. Architecturally, the station is a significant example of mid-20th-century modernist architecture in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The central element of the station is the spacious railway hall with a floor plan in the shape of a ring segment, divided into nine segments with supporting columns. The hall's structure includes parabolic hyperboloids of prestressed reinforced concrete, creating a dynamic, curved roof line. The wings of the building are arranged around the central hall and are connected to the railway platforms and other functional spaces. With its monumental presence and functionality, the station is a symbol of architectural innovation of that era, while subsequent renovations, particularly after the damage sustained during the 1992–1995 war, have preserved its architectural and cultural value.

Exhibition Design

The Exhibition Advisory Board (Curatorial Team) will coordinate the work on the Exhibition until a final decision is made on the projects to be presented, ensuring a diverse and representative selection that highlights the range and significance of contributions by prominent architects.

A special architectural project will be the design of the Exhibition itself, arising from individual proposals by each exhibitor, the possibilities of the space, and an architectural competition, which will include planning the layout to create a coherent and engaging flow, guiding visitors through the exhibition and enhancing their understanding and appreciation of the displayed works.

Necessary interpretive materials, including descriptions, labels, and background information for each piece, will be prepared. These materials should be available in both our language and English to cater to a broader audience and provide deeper insight into the context and significance of each work.

Marketing i promocija

Za promociju i marketing izložbe “d.i.a.SPONA” bit će izrađen sveobuhvatan plan, koji će osigurati široku vidljivost i visoku posjećenost događaja. Plan će obuhvatiti različite kanale komunikacije, uključujući društvene mreže, medijske objave, distribuciju letaka i druge promotivne aktivnosti kako bi se obavijestila raznolika publika, od stručne zajednice do šire javnosti. Jedan od ključnih elemenata promocije jeste komunikacijska strategija, koja će obuhvatiti precizno planirane vremenske korake kako bi se promocija odvijala pravovremeno i efikasno. Stručna agencija preuzet će odgovornost za PR kampanju, uključujući kreiranje i implementaciju kampanje, lobiranje medija te organizaciju TV gostovanja. Time se omogućava visoka profesionalnost i usmjerenost komunikacije prema ciljanoj publici.

Centralni događaj PR kampanje bit će pres-konferencija, koja će okupiti ključne medijske predstavnike. Organizacija pres-konferencije uključuje sve korake od pozivanja medija, moderiranja događaja do kreiranja i distribucije saopćenja.

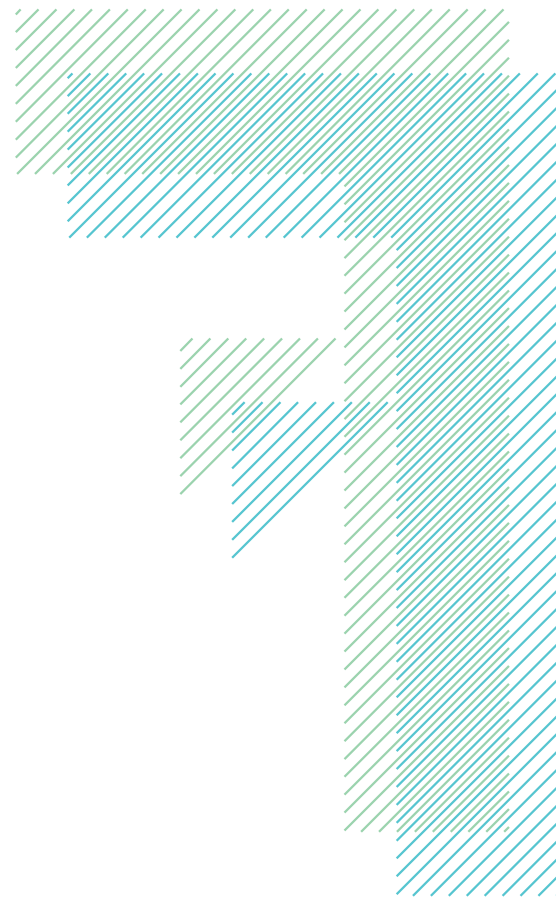
Kada je riječ o društvenim mrežama, kreirat će se i voditi specijalizirani sadržaji prilagođeni različitim platformama. Cilj je ne samo informirati publiku o događaju već i angažirati ih kroz interaktivne postove, analize i praćenje interakcije na mrežama. Praćenje analitika omogućit će prilagođavanje sadržaja u realnom vremenu kako bi se postigli maksimalni rezultati u vidljivosti i angažmanu.

Paralelno s ovim aktivnostima bit će organizirana i distribucija letaka i drugih štampanih materijala za promociju izložbe na ključnim lokacijama u gradu, kao što su kulturni centri, fakulteti i javni prostori. Ove aktivnosti imaju za cilj doprijeti do šire javnosti i osigurati njihovo sudjelovanje na izložbi.

Osim promotivnih aktivnosti poseban fokus bit će stavljen na stručnu javnost kroz objavljivanje dviju knjiga. One će biti ključni elementi promocije među arhitektonskom zajednicom. Put u arhitekturu sadržavat će kratke biografije, profesionalne priče odabranih arhitekata i dio iz opsega njihovih radova, a Zbornik radova ponudit će eseje, predavanja, izlaganja na panel-diskusijama i druge radove napravljene povodom održavanja izložbe.

Potencijalna partnerstva s institucijama, kao što su Univerzitet u Sarajevu, Grad Sarajevo, Kanton Sarajevo i drugi nivoi uprave u Bosni i Hercegovini, dodatno će pojačati vidljivost izložbe i osigurati njen uspjeh.

Na kraju, sve aktivnosti bit će pažljivo praćene i dokumentirane kroz press clipping, odnosno detaljan izvještaj o medijskim objavama, što će omogućiti procjenu uspješnosti kampanje i daljnje unapređenje sličnih projekata u budućnosti.



Marketing and Promotion

A comprehensive plan will be developed for the promotion and marketing of the d.i.a.spona exhibition to ensure broad visibility and high attendance. The plan will cover various communication channels, including social media, media releases, leaflet distribution, and other promotional activities, to inform a diverse audience ranging from professionals to the general public.

A key element of the promotion will be the communication strategy, which will include precisely planned timelines to ensure timely and effective promotion. A specialised agency will be responsible for the PR campaign, including creating and implementing the campaign, media lobbying, and organising TV appearances. This approach ensures high professionalism and targeted communication to the intended audience.

The central event of the PR campaign will be a press conference, which will gather key media representatives. Organising the press conference includes all steps from inviting the media, moderating the event, to creating and distributing press releases.

For social media, specialised content tailored to different platforms will be created and managed. The aim is not only to inform the public about the event but also to engage them through interactive posts, analyses, and monitoring of interactions on social media. Analytics tracking will enable real-time adjustments to content to achieve maximum visibility and engagement.

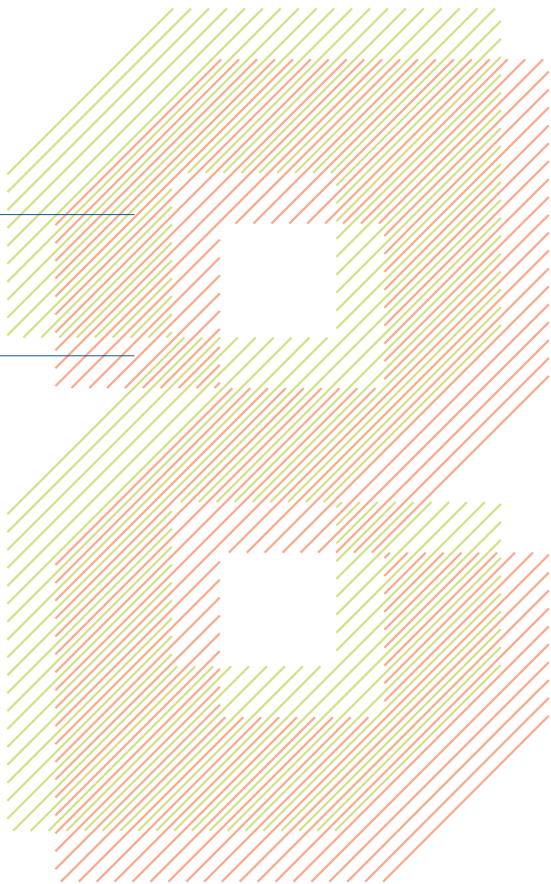
Alongside these activities, leaflet and other printed material distribution will be organised to promote the exhibition at key locations in the city, such as cultural centres, universities, and public spaces. These activities aim to reach a broader audience and ensure their participation in the exhibition.

In addition to promotional activities, special focus will be placed on the professional community through the publication of two books, which will be key elements of the promotion within the architectural community. “Path to Architecture” will contain short biographies, professional stories of selected architects, and excerpts of their work, while “Proceedings” will include essays, lectures, panel discussions, and other works produced in connection with the exhibition.

Potential partnerships with institutions such as the University of Sarajevo, City of Sarajevo, Sarajevo Canton, and other levels of government in BiH will further enhance the visibility of the exhibition and ensure its success. Finally, all activities will be carefully monitored and documented through press clippings, providing a detailed report on media coverage, which will allow for the assessment of the campaign’s success and the further improvement of similar projects in the future.

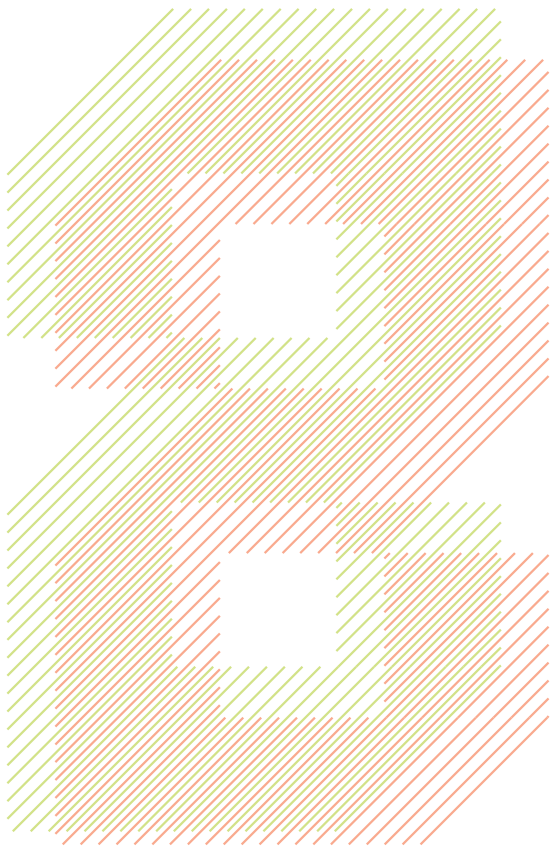
